MHC Updates

The 1st Quarter brought:

- 11 new volunteers, 78 students, 5 different groups comprised of 65 individuals and a minimum of 120 weekly volunteers over the first 3 months, for a grand total of **1,714 individuals volunteering**

Lisa and Victor turn to MHC after Hurricane Florence

Lisa and Victor are a young couple who came to Matthews HELP Center for help after Hurricane Florence recently hit our area. With a young child at home, they were already on a very tight budget, but when Florence brought flooding conditions, both of their employers decided to halt business. Their home was affected by the widespread power outages, which resulted in loss of their perishable food items. The closure of both of their employers meant no pay for the couple, which caused them to get behind in rent and when they came to MHC they were already under eviction proceedings. Matthews HELP Center was able to help them with housing to avoid eviction, food to replenish lost items, and referrals to help them overcome their crisis. Victor is now back at work and Lisa will be able to get back to work once all of the repairs have been made to her workplace.
